
- If the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by manufacturer or its service agent or a similarly qualified person in order to avoid a hazard.

- When the fan was assembled, the rotor blade guard shall not be taken off anymore.
 - Prior cleaning unplug the fan.
 - The rotor guard shall not be dissembled/opened to clean the rotor blades.
 - Wipe the fan enclosure and rotor blade guard with a slightly damp cloth.



PRODUCT INSTALLATION

Installation Procedures

1 Base and Stand Connection

1.1 Align the interface between the stand and the base, and then rotate clockwise to tighten it.




2 Stand and Motor Connection

2.1 Insert the connector under the motor house into the stand interface, and then rotate clockwise to tighten it.




3 Rear Grille and Motor Connection

3.1 First, remove the blade lock nut and rear grille lock nut from the motor assembly.




- 3.2 Place the rear grille against the motor housing and align the motor housing's pin and rear grille's hole.
- 3.3 Lock the rear grille by rotating the rear grille lock nut clockwise.



4 Blade Attachment

4.1 Place the blade through the motor's shaft while aligning the shaft's pegs with the blade's slots.




4.2 While holding the blade, screw the blade lock nut on by rotating it counterclockwise.



5 Front Grille Attachment


Align the front grille's arrow with the rear grille's $\stackrel{\cdot}{\leftarrow}$ and snap the front grille in place with both hands. Then rotate the front grille's arrow to the rear grille's $\stackrel{\cdot}{\leftarrow}$, and fasten the screw.

Note: Two screws come in the package but only one is needed.




6 Oscillation control

To make the fan oscillate, push down on the oscillation knob located on the top of the motor housing. To stop the fan from oscillating, pull up the oscillating knob.



OPERATION INSTRUCTIONS

Instructions for Operation of Body



	Function description
0	Press this button to stop the product.
1	Press this button to low speed.
2	Press this button to medium speed.
3	Press this button to high speed.

CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

The fan requires minimal maintenance. Do not try to fix it by yourself. Refer it to qualified service personnel if service is needed.

- 1. Before cleaning and assembling, unplug the fan power.
- 2. To ensure adequate air circulation to the motor, keep vents at the rear of the motor free of dust. Do not disassemble the fan to remove dust.
 - Please wipe the exterior parts with a soft cloth soaking a mild detergent.
- 3. Do not use any abrasive detergent or solvents to avoid scratching the surface.
- 4.Do not use any of the following as a cleaner: gasoline, thinner.
- 5. Do not allow water or any other liquid entering into the motor housing or interior parts.
- 6. Be sure to unplug from the electrical supply source before cleaning.
- 7. Plastic parts should be cleaned with a soft cloth moisten with mild soap Thoroughly remove soapsuds with dry cloth.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Operation of your appliance can lead to errors and malfunctions. The following tables contain possible causes and notes for resolving an error message or malfunction. It is recommended to read the table below carefully in order to save your time and money that may cost for calling to the service center.

Problem	Cause	Solution
The machine does not work properly after installed	• The power cable is not plugged in or has poor contact.	Make sure the plug is properly inserted into the socket.
	The switch on the body is not turned on.	Turn on the switch on the body.
