- This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety. Children shall not play with the appliance. Cleaning and user maintenance shall not be made by children without supervision. If the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent or similarly qualified persons in order to avoid a hazard.
- There shall be adequate ventilation of the room when the range hood is used at the same time as appliances burning gas or other fuels.
- Please do not use corrosive detergent for cleaning. The proper function of the unit is conditioned by the regularity of the maintenance.
- To protect the main body from corrosive of the long time accumulation of dirt, the cooker hood should be cleaned with hot water with non-corrosive detergent every two months.
- There is a fire risk if cleaning is not carried out in accordance with the instructions.
- Do not flame under the range hood.
- The air must not be discharged into a flue that is used for exhausting fumes from appliances burning gas or other fuels.
- The minimum distance between the supporting surface for the cooking vessels on the hob and the lowest part of the range hood (When the range hood is located above a gas appliance ,this distance shall be at least 65cm, If the instructions for instllation for the gas hob specify a greater distance, this has to be taken into account. The distance of 65cm can be reduced for)

- Regulations concerning the discharge of air have to be fulfilled.
- The appliance uses 4 hob elements at most.
- **CAUTION:** Accessible parts may become hot when used with cooking appliances.
- Lamp information

The air flow parameter is tested under conditions of $230V \sim /50Hz$ when the voltage is $220-240V \sim /50Hz$.

Safety Warning

This appliance can be used by children aged from 8 years and above and persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge if they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance in a safe way and understangd the hazards involved. Children shall not play with the appliance. Cleaning and user maintenance.

- The appliance is not intended for use by young children or infirm persons without supervisions.
- Young children should be supervised to ensure they do not play with the appliance.
- Plug the power cord to socket outlet with earthing continuity terminal.
- The cooker hood is for home use only, not suitable for barbecue, roast shop and other commercial purposes.
- The cooker hood and its filter should be cleaned regularly according to the instruction.
- Do not use open flame, or allow oil to go beneath the appliance.
- If there is any fault occurred with the appliance, please call after-sale service department.
- Please keep the kitchen room ventilated.
- Prior to any maintenance, cleaning operation, ensure the power is cut off.
- If the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, service agent or similarly qualified person in order to avoid a hazard. The replaced power cord should be provided by manufacturer or seller.
- If the plug or cord is damaged, please call after-sale service center.
- There is a fire risk if cleaning is not carried out in accordance with the instruction.
- In case of damaged connecting wire, please refer to the manufacturer, after-sale service personnel or other qualified technicians.
- Use the unit according to the instructions to avoid any fire hazard.
- The exhaust air must not be introduced into a smoke flue or chimney that is used for exhausting fumes from appliances burning gas.
- Follow the local laws applicable for external air evacuation.

Determine location

Range hood should be installed horizontaly on the top of the stove, the installation diagram is as follows:

Range hood can be used after power.



\bigcirc	Light	Press: Turn on the light.	
\bigcirc	High speed	Turn on the power; Press Hight speed :Turn on high speed;	
\bigcirc	Low speed	Press Low speed : Turn on low speed. (Two patterns can't run at the same time)	
\bigcirc	Switch	1 st Short press: Start up (speed); 2 nd Short press: End (speed).	

Internal cleaning



Unplug the power cord, unscrew the screws for fixing cover.





Remove screw, take down the rack cover plate.





Loose the nut according to instruction, take out the impeller.





Clean the impeller and volute with neutral detergent, install them accoring to reverse order of disassembly.

Safety Caution Dis

Dismantle the filter to clean the impeller and volute, needs to be completed by professionals.



Remove the decorative cover.





Remove screw, take down the air inlet ring.



Surface cleaning

Recommendation after cooking with a dry cloth or a wet cloth moistened with neutral detergent to clean the inside and outside surfaces of the machine. Do not use clean balls, brushes or coarse cloth to avoid scratching the machine surface.

Oil cup installation:

The cup holder into the buckle in the air inlet hood, Return the oil cup horizontally with both hands

Oil cup disassemble:

Hold the oil cup edge with both hands, Move it.





Suggestion:

Clean the air inlet hood every 2 weeks or no less than every month.

How to clean:

- 1. Unsrew the air inlet hood and take it out.
- 2. Put the hood into warm water with neutral detergent.
- 3. Clean it with a soft brush.
- 4. Mounting it when it's dried.
- 5. Install the air inlet hood.

- 4) The product's purchase proof has been altered.
- 5) The product model and body code registered on installation service card is inconsistent with the model and body code of the product to be repaired.
- 6) The product damaged due to the instability of power voltage or exceeding normal voltage scope (198-242) V.a.c, or power circuit installation not meeting the national electrical installation requirement.
- The product sold at discounted price or with "OFF-Grade" and "Substandard Goods" printed on installation service card or the body.
- 8) Product damaged due to irresistible natural disaster.
- 9) Product warranty period is expired.
- 10) The product damaged by the unsuitable and improper method specified in instruction book.

Fourth, if your reasonable service demand can't be solved by special service department or dissatisfaction with their service, please make an immediate call or write a letter to our customer service center, we will provide you with our service.
