Safety Precautions

Observe the following items in order to prevent injuries from and damages to the machine.

Please use the new hose sets provided with the machine, old hose sets should not be used.


If power cord is damaged, only the manufacturer, service agent or qualified person should repair it in order to avoid hazard.

The openings must not be obstructed with a carpet.


If strong vibration occurs during the spinning process, open the spin cover immediately. Make sure that the washing machine is placed on a flat and stable floor, and distribute the clothes evenly.

To do spinning and draining together, please spin for 1 minute before draining.


Do not wash or spin waterproof clothes or clothes that float easily to avoid abnormal vibration or damage to the clothes.





INSTALLATION



located at the spin side. According to the installation site, the drain hose can also be installed at the wash side of the machine. The method is as follows:

- 1. Unplug the power cord and empty water in the drain hose completely.
- 2. Spread a piece of soft cloth on the floor (e.g. blanket) and place the washing machine on it gently.
- 3. Take the drain hose out from the buckle at the spin side and put it into the buckle at the wash side.
- 4. Hang up the drain hose kit

PREPARATION BEFORE USE

- Plug to power supply and connect the water inlet hose to faucet.
- Lay down the drain hose and connect it to the sewer.
- Make sure that there are no objects such as coins, hairpins, mud or sand in the pocket.
- Strings should be knotted to prevent it from tangling.
- Clothes can be sorted for washing according to the texture, dirt degree and/or color.
- For small pieces (e.g., stockings) or fluffy clothes, put them in a nylon net for washing.



PARTS OF THE WASHING MACHINE

Name of Parts




• Water Inlet: Connects the hose from the water faucet to supply water to the tub

- · Wash Timer: Used to select the desired time for washing or rinsing
- Spin Timer: Used to select the desired time for spinning
- Wash Selector: Used to choose desired wash setting depending on the type of laundry.

* For reference only, actual control panel may vary depending on the model.

QUICK START



Washing Method

- 1. Connect the water inlet hose into the water inlet.
- 2. Put the laundry into the wash tub, add detergent and water into the wash tub. When water level reaches half of the desired level, turn off the faucet and let the laundry soak in the solution for a couple of minutes after which, fill up to the desired water level.
- 3. Set the desired wash time using the wash timer knob.
- When washing is finished, set the drain selector to "DRAIN" position and drain the wash tub.

Rinsing Method

- A. Spraying Rinse (rinse in the spin tub)
- 1. Put the laundry into the spin tub after washing.
- 2. Transfer the water inlet hose to the water inlet at the spin side.
- 3. Turn on the water tap for 3-4 minutes.
- 4. Set the spin timer for 2-5 minutes for rinsing.
- 5. The above steps may be repeated.

Note:

If there is rust in the water, do not choose spraying rinse because rust easily stains clothes.
 Make sure not to fill water into the spin tub while it is spinning.

USAGE METHOD

B. Common Rinse (rinse in the wash tub)

- 1. To save time, water and energy, do pre-spinning before rinsing.
- 2. Put clothes that have been spun, into the wash tub.
- 3. When water level reaches the desired level, turn off the faucet.

4. Turn the "Wash Selector" knob to "Normal" or Heavy".

- 5. Set the wash timer to the desired time for rinsing, about 3 5 minutes.
- 6. After rinsing, put clothes in the spin tub and spin for 1 5 minutes.
- 7. When finished, set the drain selector to the "DRAIN" position and drain the wash tub.
- 8. The above steps can be repeated.

Spinning Method

1. Load the laundry evenly into the spin tub.	2. Put the spinner cap on the laundry. Make sure that the spinner cap is placed horizontally

Efficiency Program (for efficiency program only)

Select Heavy in the wash selector, set wash time to 15 minutes using 40°C warm water and spin twice, 3 minutes each time. Rinse for 5 minutes with 20°C cold water and spin twice, 3 minutes each.



Frame

Cabinet

1. Remove all screws of the frame with a screw driver and loosen the connector of the brake belt.

2. Pull up the frame with both hands and turn the frame backwards.

- 3. Take out the clothes or objects.
- 4. Fasten the connector of the brake belt. Put back the frame and tighten the screws.

△ After using the washing machine, never forget to do the following:

- 1. Disconnect the power plug.
- 2. Remove the water inlet hose.

If the following symptoms occur, please disconnect the power plug and perform the following checks:

Symptom	Reason		
The washing machine does not work.	 Check that the power supply is in good condition. Check that the power plug is inserted properly. Check that the wash timer knob or the spin timer knob is not in the "0" position. 		
The drain hose does not work.	 Check that the drain hose is not laid too high. Check that the drain hose is not blocked by foreign matter. 		
There is abnormal noise during washing.	 Check that there are no coins or any other foreign objects dropped into the wash tub. 		
There is abnormal noise and violent vibration during spinning.	 Check that the washing machine is placed on flat, stable floor. Check that clothes are evenly distributed in the spin tub. Check that there are no clothes or detergent foam outside the spin tub (but within the cabinet).
