



Appliances are not intended to be operated by means of an external timer or separate remote-control system.

Please follow the correct instruction to use the product, to avoid to cause serious personal injury.

Don't touch the heated element surface after used.

Please read the safety instructions before use the appliance, for avoid to cause the risk of fire, electric hazard and personal injury.

- 1. This appliance is not intended for use by children over eight years of age or persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge. Unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety, Children should not use this appliance.
- 2. This appliance is not designed for use by persons with reduced physical. sensory or mental capabilities (including children), or lack relevant knowledge or experience, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning safe use of the appliance and understand the risks involved. The cleaning and maintenance of this appliance must not be performed by children children without supervision.
- 3. Keep distance with the children included the appliance and power cord; Ensure the children do not play with the appliance.
- 4. Do not touch the hot surface! The main body will become hot during long time use. Please hold the handles at main body if need to move the appliance.
- 5. CAUTION: To reduce the risk or electric shock, cook only in removable container only.
- 6. WARNING: Please pay attention to the ingredients overflow the pot due to boiling, to avoid serious scald.
- 7. WARNING: Spilled food can cause serious burns.
- 8. Close supervision is necessary when the appliance is operating by or near children
- 9. To protect against electrical shock, do not immerse cord, plug, or cooker body in water or other liquid.
- 10. Do not add water close to the edge of inner pot, or the water will flow out durina cookina.
- 11. Unplug the appliance when do not in use and before cleaning. Allow to cool before putting on or taking off parts, and before cleaning the appliance.
- 12. Do not use the appliance once the power cord/appliance damaged, please contact with Midea customer service center for repair.
- 13. To avoid danger happen, please use the authorized accessory or parts.


- 14. This product is for household use only, intended for countertop use only.
- 15. The appliance is only for cooking purpose.
- 16. This product is for household use only, do not use outdoors.
- 17. Please be careful to move the appliance if the inner pot with hot liquids.
- 18. Do not let cord hang over edge of table and counter, or touch hot surface.
- 19. A short power-supply cord is used to reduce the risk resulting from it being grabbed by children, becoming entangled in, or tripping over a longer cord.
- 20. In the first time to use this appliance, ensure that the power rating in conformity with the current power rate.
- 21. DO NOT place unit on or near a hot gas or electric burner, or in a heated oven.
- 22. DO NOT put frozen articles inside the inner pot when it is too much heat, or wash the inner pot with the cold water.
- 23. DO NOT uncover the lid when in stewing, otherwise the temperature come down and more stewing time will be needed.
- 24. DO NOT cooking food directly in the Aluminum pot.
- 25. DO NOT place the inner pot on gas stove.
- 26. To avoid any cracks or spoilage that may bring to the slow cooker, proper maintenance is necessary..
- 27. Only carry the slow cooker from the side handles on the cooking base. Do NOT carry from the handle on the lid ,even when locked.
- 28. CAUTION: to prevent damage to the appliance do not use alkaline cleaning agents when cleaning, use a soft cloth and a mild detergent.cedera.
- 29. Caution, hot surface. The surfaces are liable to get hot during use.
- 30. Use a cloth to clean the baking tray and utensils after cooking terpisah.
- 31. WARNING: The appliance must never be used with oil, it should not be used as a frying pan or deep fat fryer!
- 32. Warning: Avoid spillage on the connector;



3 Put the seasoning in the baking pan.






2 Turn the adjusting knob in the


4 Add food.



5 Put on the glass cover, start cooking, open the glass cover and stir the food at the right time to ensure uniform heating.



6 After cooking, unplug the power cord and wipe the baking tray with a wet towel after cooling down.



CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

- Please be sure to unplug the power cord plug after each use, wait for a few minutes after power failure, and then wipe it with a damp cloth. If it is stored for a long time, it should be cleaned with detergent.
- Do not use abrasive cleaning products or solvents for cleaning.
- Do not put the product in water for cleaning in case of electric shock and malfunction.
- Dry all components before storage and put the product in a safe and dry place.
